

## Clear Hills Watershed Initiative (CHWI)

Enter a “Photo-rific” Watershed Contest in 2016

Here in Clear Hills County, or wherever you live, you live in a watershed. A watershed is an area of land where all of the water that is under it, or drains off of it, goes into the same place. This water from precipitation (rain and snow) travels over, or through, the watershed’s soil, groundwater, creeks and streams; finding its way into larger rivers and eventually the ocean. In Clear Hills County of northwest Alberta, we are within the Peace River Watershed. And, we live, work and play in a terrific place! So, we are counting on you to help show the world through your images! Enter your photos of plants, animals, work, play, landscapes and/or history within Clear Hills County. Along with a completed entry form, submit each “photo-rific” image, in digital or print format.

Each contestant can only enter a max of 2 photos per category.

Enter in any of the following four categories:

- 1) Winter
- 2) Spring
- 3) Summer
- 4) Fall

Entrants will be judged either as Youth (17 years of age and under) or Adult (18 years of age and over).

Rules: Open to all residents of Clear Hills County. All entries become the property of the CHWI (non-returnable) for our potential use. These include on our website, in presentations and in selected publications. Credit will be given to the photographer unless you have specified otherwise upon entering.

1st place and runner-ups in each category will be awarded from each youth and adult entries. Only 1st place will receive a prize.

The CHWI thanks each participant for entering, however, only those chosen winners will be contacted. Photo-rific contest winners will be announced at the CHWI Annual Supper in March 2016 and posted to our website. Contest opens January 1, 2016. All entries must be received in either electronic or print format by 4:00 p.m., MST, March 1, 2016. Entries by email must be in a JPEG format (with a resolution of at least 300 PPI) accompanied by a completed entry form. Low resolution digital images that cannot be produced in high quality will be disqualified.
